ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE**

The Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) is a comprehensive planning document commissioned by the County of Marin as part of its mandate to affirmatively further fair housing. The draft AI is posted on www.marincdbg.com. The AI identifies barriers to fair housing choice in Marin County and includes an implementation plan to address barriers. The County is soliciting public comment on the completeness of the list of issues in the AI and priorities and methods for addressing those issues.

A Subcommittee of the Community Development Block Grant Countywide Priority Setting Committee has been established to hear additional public comment on the AI, including its implementation plan, and to recommend revisions to the AI. The Subcommittee will hold two public meetings at which public comment will be welcome:

- ◆ **Monday, July 25, 2011**, at 7:00 p.m., in the Multipurpose Room, Marguerita C. Johnson Senior Center, 640 Drake Avenue, Marin City, California, and
- ◆ **Wednesday, July 27, 2011**, at 7:00 p.m., in Room #9 (Teen Lounge), Pickleweed Park Community Center, 50 Canal Street, San Rafael, California.

The public meeting locations are accessible by wheelchair and public transportation.
