This table was prepared by the Marin Housing Authority. The figures shown above are based on the FY 2007 Median Family Income (MFI) for the San Francisco HMFA (a HUD-defined metropolitan area consisting of part of an OMB-defined Metropolitan Statistical Area) comprised of San Francisco, San Mateo and Marin Counties. The FY2007 median family income for the San Francisco HMFA for a four-person household is \$86,500, as determined by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD") effective 3/20/07. This figure is adjusted for household size using HUD standard adjustment factors. All figures are rounded to the nearest \$50.

The San Francisco HMFA is a subset of the San Francisco-Oakland-Fremont Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA), which is an OMB-defined metropolitan core-based statistical area (CBSA).
